**AGREED ORDER GRANTING CORPORATE MONITOR'S EMERGENCY
MOTION TO EXPAND CORPORATE MONITORSHIP OVER OM GLOBAL LP**

THIS CAUSE, having come before the Court upon the Corporate Monitor's Emergency Motion to Expand Corporate Monitorship over OM Global LP (the "Motion"), and the Court, having reviewed the relevant pleadings, been apprised of the agreement of counsel, and being otherwise advised in the premises, it is hereby:

1. **ORDERED and ADJUDGED** that the Motion is **GRANTED**.
2. The Corporate Monitorship is hereby expanded to include OM Global LP.
3. All provisions regarding OM Global Investment Fund LLC imposed in the Agreed Order Granting Plaintiff's Unopposed Motion for Appointment of Corporate Monitor dated May 29, 2013 are hereby extended to cover OM Global LP, including the asset freeze over any and all assets and accounts of OM Global LP, as well as the Corporate Monitor's right to turnover of such.

4. In addition, any and all funds directly or indirectly derived from assets or accounts of OM Global LP are hereby frozen until further Order of this Court. Such funds, assets, or accounts include funds deposited by OM Global LP and/or transferred by OM Global LP to any third parties.

5. All provisions of the Agreed Order Granting Plaintiff's Unopposed Motion for Appointment of Corporate Monitor dated May 29, 2013 still remain in effect and are not otherwise affected by this Order.
